<u>Vendor Cost is a \$5 spot fee per market</u> (except for vendors selling only agricultural products, the fee is waived). Vendors must also pay an additional one-time \$5 fee at the market once per year for a Cottonwood Temporary Business License, good for the entirety of the 2024 Old Town Music & the Market.

All vendors requiring electricity will be charged an <u>additional \$10</u> for each market. Spaces with electricity are limited. Please check one.

Old Town Music and the Market Rules and Regulations for Vendors

- 1. Check-in each Friday begins at 3:30 pm. Event hours are 5 pm until dark.
- 2. All Vendors are required to fill out a registration form prior to participating in any "Old Town Music and The Market." All vendors preparing food must accompany this registration with a Yavapai Food Handlers Permit.
- 3. When vendors arrive on sight, they will be required to check in at the City of Cottonwood's booth. Only vendors with reserved spaces are permitted to enter the market area without checking in first.
- 4. All booth spaces will be on a "first come first serve basis" and will be assigned by the City after checking in. (If space has been reserved by a vendor this does not apply.)
- 5. All vendors requiring electricity will pay a minimal fee of \$10 per night upon check-in. Limited spots are available.
- 6. Individuals performing face painting at any City of Cottonwood events or on City property may only use face paints meant for that purpose. No acrylic craft paints, watercolor/washable markers, pencils, or metallic craft glitter may be used for face painting.
- 7. The City reserves the right to pick and choose vendors based on: an overabundance of that particular product, a vendor being unruly, or if a vendor practices bad business. In each case, the vendor will be asked to leave.
- 8. No tent stakes or any object will be driven into the ground at the Old Town Activity Park.
- 9. Vendors are not allowed to leave until the market has <u>officially</u> closed for the night and the majority of patrons have left the grounds.
- 10. All vendors (except produce) will be charged a \$5 fee for each "Old Town Music and The Market".
- 11. A one-time (at first visit each year) \$5 City of Cottonwood business registration fee will be charged to ALL participating vendors who are selling wares.
- 12. Items for RESALE are strictly PROHIBITED.

Minimal Food Booth and Mobile Food Unit Requirements

- 1. Overhead protection, three side walls, and flooring are required for food booths. Doors for Mobile Food Booths must self-close. Screening of openings may also be required. Booths selling only commercially prepackaged foods may not need to meet the booth requirements.
- 2. Accurate long stem thermometer, which reads from 0°F to 220°F.
- 3. A dishwashing set-up consisting of three basins for a wash, rinse, sanitize, and set up.
- 4. Chlorine bleach or other approved sanitizer (iodine or quaternary ammonium) must be used in the sanitizing solution for utensils & equipment AND sanitizing counters & tables. Chlorine test strips or test kits for the approved sanitizer.
- 5. Approved hand washing facilities with clean running water, soap, paper towels (separate from the dishwashing set-up), and a container to catch and hold wastewater.
- 6. All foods, ice for drinks, and water must come from approved sources. Ice scoops require handles.
- 7. Covered garbage or waste can.
- 8. Applicant and staff need to have current Yavapai County food worker Certificates.
- 9. Any off-site food preparation (if applicable) must take place in a facility approved by the Health Services. This requires a completed and approved Commissary Agreement form.
- 10. All food must come from an approved source or commissary (kitchen facility) which must be under permit and have passed necessary health department inspections.
- 11. Sales of pre-packaged and properly labeled non-potentially hazardous foods (e.g. chips, candy, canned soda, bottled water, etc...) will be allowed with minor restrictions on product storage.
- 12. Food service operations involving "complex" food preparation and cooking procedures will require a health permit and approval from Yavapai County Community Health Services.
